- ✓ Increased family engagement in learning

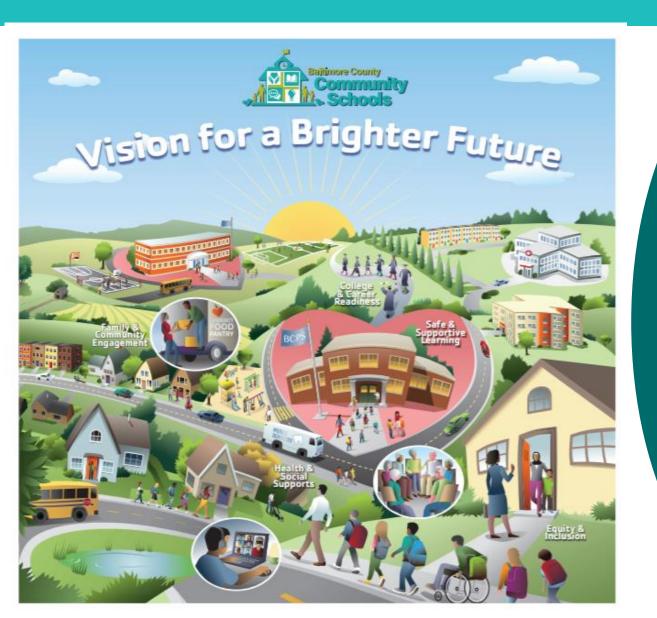

Role of the Community School Facilitator

- Guides the Needs Assessment.
- Creates the Community School team.
- Uses data to create and implement the Multi-Year Plan.
- Leverages partnerships and resources around the school and community needs.
- Maintains relationships with all stakeholder groups to move the work.
- Builds capacity of stakeholders through leadership development.
- Continually assesses where we are and where we need to go.

A Comprehensive Needs Assessment will allow us to plan for the process.

 - ★ Existing Data Review
